



Solo to Symphony

Rules of Play:

- Shuffle cards and place down to form a draw pile.
- Use M&Ms as place markers, each player with a different color.
- Youngest player draws first.
- How many musicians are on the card? Move that many places.
 - The Chamber Orchestra goes 10 places.
 - The Symphony Orchestra is treble! Go back two whole octaves or to start.
- You cannot share a note space. Move forward to the nearest free note space.
- The player that reaches “END” first wins. For younger children it may be nice to continue play, for second, or even third places as well.
